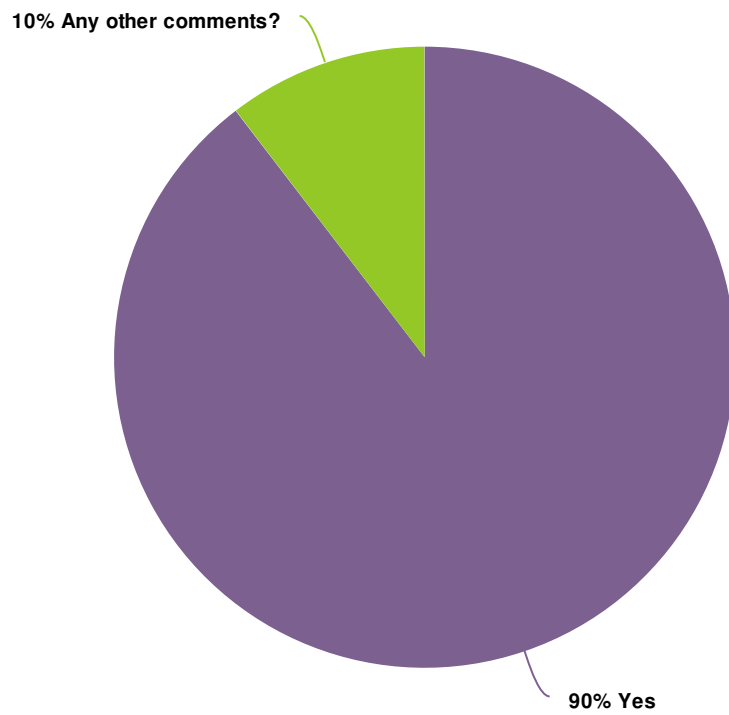


3. Did the conference meet your expectations?

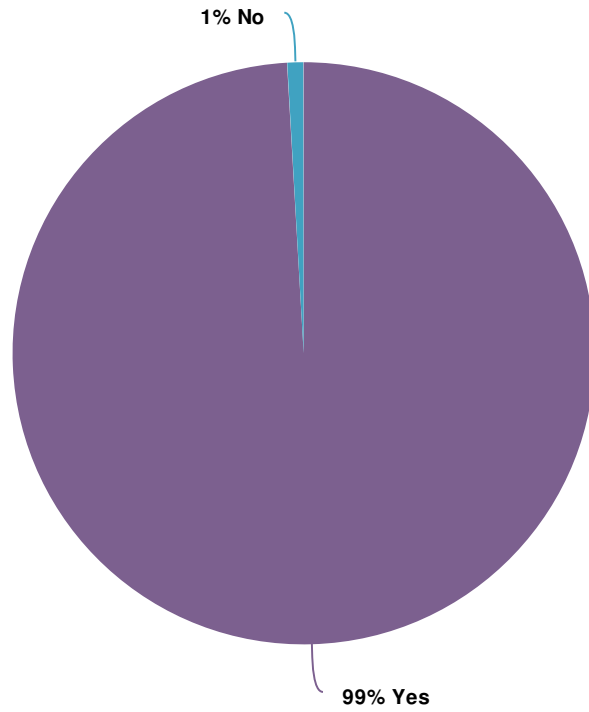
4. Did you find the conference platform easy to use?

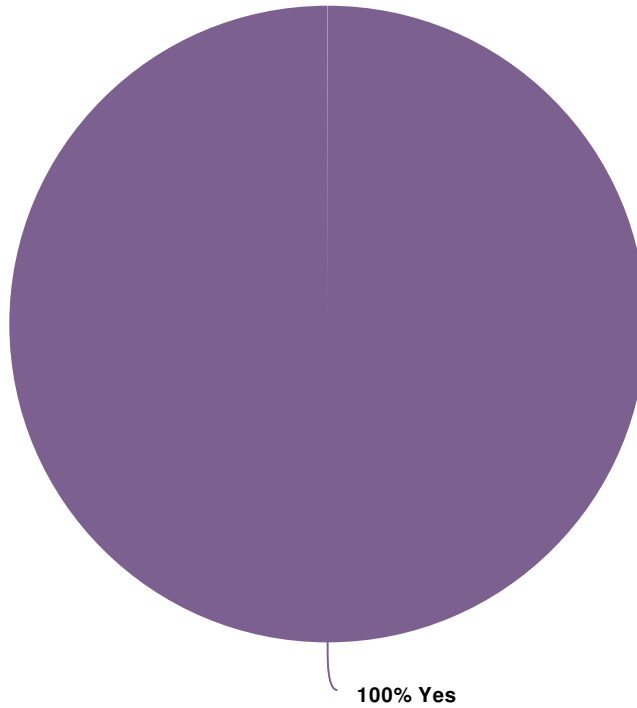

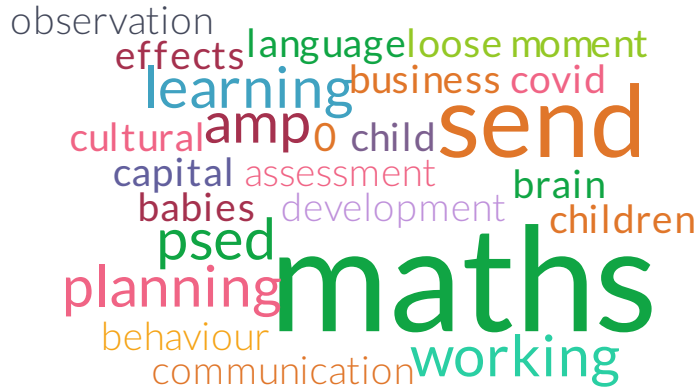

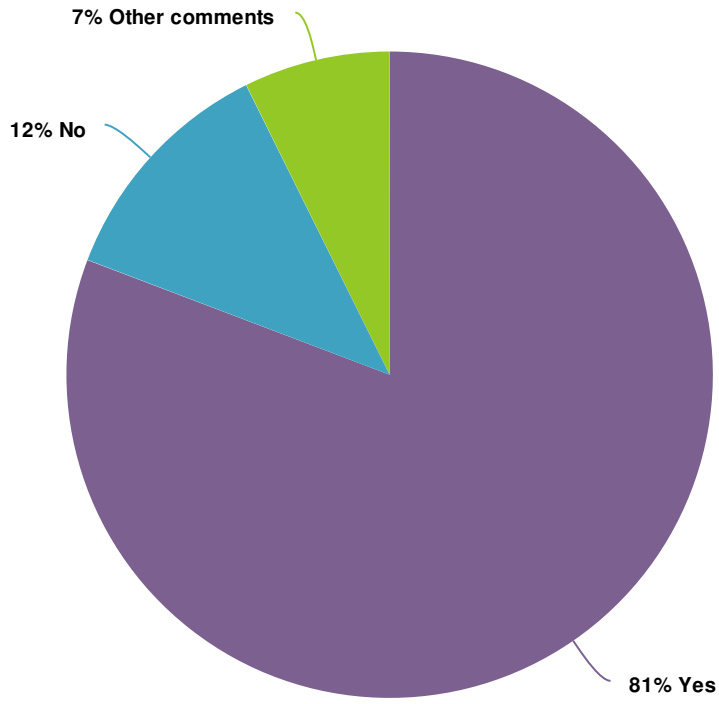
7. What overall themes would you like to see at future Nursery World events?
